Our annual report will highlight our 2016-17 work in Haiti. We helped two communities in Haiti with mini water filtration systems. These MINI filtration systems are ideal for filtering dirt and removing 99.99999% of all bacteria, such as salmonella, cholera, and E.coli.



#### ALLOCATION OF EXPENSES


